Leveraging Patient-Centered Clinical Decision Support: Addressing the National Opioid Crisis and Beyond

Patient-Centered Clinical Decision Support (PCCDS) supports individual patients and their care teams in health-related decisions and actions. PCCDS is increasingly important for addressing the national opioid crisis and other critical health concerns.

Today, new technologies and the growing availability of health data are providing unique opportunities for patients, caregivers, clinicians, vendors, and other stakeholders to transform how PCCDS is developed and used to address the opioid crisis and other pressing healthcare challenges.

The Patient-Centered Clinical Decision Support Learning Network (PCCDS-LN), supported by the Agency for Healthcare Research and Quality, has worked with stakeholders to develop a draft National Opioid Action Plan leveraging the power of PCCDS.

On October 15, 2018, the PCCDS-LN is hosting a one-day conference to bring together diverse stakeholders to learn about and discuss key issues in drafting a National Opioid Action Plan. We will also set an agenda for developing, disseminating, and applying PCCDS in other domains.
