Optimizing Health through Patient-Facing Clinical Decision Support

Patient-Centered Clinical Decision Support (PCCDS) supports individual patients and their care teams in health-related decisions and actions. Emerging technologies and the transition to more data transparency provide unique opportunities for patients, caregivers, clinicians, vendors, and other stakeholders to transform how PCCDS is developed and used within the healthcare industry.

The Patient-Centered Clinical Decision Support Learning Network (PCCDS-LN), an Agency for Healthcare Research and Quality (AHRQ) supported effort, is again hosting its one-day annual conference on October 21, 2019 bringing together diverse stakeholders to learn about and discuss making PCCDS a reality. The format of the meeting will be geared toward collaborative learning, which provides ample opportunities for networking and interactions.

Connectathon: This year we will also be holding a Connectathon aimed at providing support for connecting FHIR-based, patient-facing apps to a variety of electronic health record, personal health record, and/or patient portal platforms.
